Committee Reports

Mr. Chastain reported that the Planning Board met and approved an addition of two bays to the Hunter Peterbuilt building.

Mr. Chastain noted that the Animal Pound Rules and Regulations policy is 98% complete. There is a need for some last minute changes. Mr. Chastain will make sure the Committee has a chance to review the policy prior to Thursday night's meeting.

Mr. McDade noted that there are numerous properties that have tall grass. The Part Time Highway Employees are doing well handling the grass. The new contract for lawn maintenance should help the Township not get out of control with the number of properties.

Mr. Barnhart reported that the Recreation Council had inquired about a skate boarding park within the Township Park. Mr. Barnhart noted that in 2005 the Joint Insurance Fund (JIF) would not insure such a facility.

The Township Clerk noted that the Department of Transportation Federal Grant Standard Operating Procedure policies have been accepted by the State.

Chief Cummings advised that the Police Department has one officer out until mid-June and another out until July.

Chief Cummings noted that he will be attending a meeting of the Septemberfest Committee to go over security for the annual event.

Robin Trudell, Deputy Animal Control Officer, reported that the pound has been very busy. This week the Municipal Court will hear 20 summonses.
