Ordinance A-4-2020

Title: AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSVILLE, COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$35,000 FROM THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSVILLE'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND GENERAL CAPITAL SURPLUS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A FORD F150 PICKUP TRUCK

WHEREAS, the Mayor and members of the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsville (hereinafter Committee) have determined that the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Township of Pennsville require that they purchase a new ford F150 truck to be utilized by the Township's Recreation Department or another department should the Committee so determine; and

WHEREAS, the Township administrator has advised the Committee that the truck can be purchased under state contract number 17-FLEET-00212 for the sum of \$35,000.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and members of the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsville, County of Salem, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The sum of \$35,000 is hereby appropriated from the Township of Pennsville's "Capital Improvement Fund" which amount shall be used to purchase a Ford F150 pickup truck to be assigned to the Township's rec department, or another department should the Committee so determine.
2. The Capital Budget of the Township of Pennsville is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies therewith. The resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing in full detail the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.
3. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.
4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances heretofore adopted and that are inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
5. This ordinance shall be effective after the final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
