ORDINANCE A- 18-2022

Title: AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSVILLE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 1 SECTION 7B OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSVILLE ENTITLED "UNCLAIMED SICK PAY" WHICH AMENDMENT WILL INCLUDE LANGUAGE REQUIRED BY NEW JERSEY PUBLIC LAW 2010 CHAPTER 3 WHICH RESTRICTS THE AMOUNT OF SICK TIME PAYOUTS

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 2, Article 1 of the Revised Ordinances of the Township of Pennsville provides for the payment of unclaimed sick pay to Township of Pennsville retirees hired subsequent to May 14, 1996; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsville has been notified by the New Jersey State Office of the Comptroller New Jersey P.L. 2010 c3 restricts such payments to a maximum payout of \$15,000.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsville, in the County of Salem, State of New Jersey, as follows:

REPEALED

1. Chapter 2, Article 7, Section 7B of the Revised Ordinances of Pennsville is hereby repealed.

ADOPTION

2. Chapter 2, Article 7, Section 7B entitled "**UNCLAIMED SICK PAY**" is hereby adopted and shall read as follows:
  - i. **UNCLAIMED SICK PAY**: In addition to the above benefit, such person shall be further entitled to receive up to thirty-five (35) days of unused or unclaimed sick pay benefit, such benefit to be calculated at the daily rate of pay in effect at the time of retirement. This benefit shall not exceed \$15,000 per State of New Jersey P.L. 2010 Chapter 3. This benefit shall not be paid to any person hired by the Township of Pennsville subsequent to May 14, 1996, unless such benefit is specifically provided in a negotiated labor contract.
3. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.




