Title: AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSVILLE AMENDING CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 5 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSVILLE WHICH ARTICLE IS ENTITLED "OTHER FEES"

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsville has determined that it is both necessary and proper to amend Chapter 5, Article 5, which section regulates the fees rendered by the Animal Control Officer within the Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** that the Revised Ordinances of the Township of Pennsville and more specifically Chapter 5, Article 5 sub-sections A through G be amended to read as follows:

1.       A.     For each dog or cat picked up  
              1<sup>st</sup> Offense     \$25.00  
              2<sup>nd</sup> Offense     \$50.00  
              3<sup>rd</sup> + Offense  \$100.00
  - B.     First day impoundment if dog or cat is picked up as a result of a complaint  
              \$4.00
  - C.     Each subsequent days of impoundment     \$4.00
  - D.     Picking up dead cat                             \$25.00
  - E.     Picking up dead dog                             \$60.00 – 100.00 (Depending on size)
  - F.     Microchip   \$20.00
  - G.     Quarantine dog/cat per day                     \$20.00
2.     If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.
3.     All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances heretofore adopted and that are inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


