Title:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSVILLE, COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$80,000.00 FROM THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSVILLE'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF AIR PACKS FOR USE BY THE DEEPWATER FIRE COMPANY, IMPROVEMENTS TO PENNSVILLE FIRE HOUSE, IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWN HALL, EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE AMBULANCE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Mayor and members of the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsville (hereinafter Committee) have determined that the health, safety and welfare of the employees and citizens of the Township of Pennsville require that air packs be purchased for use by the Deepwater Fire Company, improvements to be made to the Township's Town Hall and Pennsville Fire House and for the purchase of equipment for use by the Ambulance Department; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and members of the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsville, County of Salem, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The sum of \$80,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Township of Pennsville's "Capital Improvement Fund" in the Current Capital Fund which amount shall be used to effectuate the development as stated above.
- 2. The Capital Budget of the Township of Pennsville is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies therewith. The resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing in full detail the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.
- 3. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.
- 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances heretofore adopted and that are inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- 5. This ordinance shall be effective after the final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
